Action for Stammering Children (ASC) is a UK charity which aims for a society where children and young people who stammer have the same opportunities and quality of life as their peers. Our goal is to ensure that every child and young person across the UK who stammers has access to effective services and support to help them meet the challenges they face.

Based in The Michael Palin Centre for Stammering Children (MPC), the charity is a strong supporter, commissioning specialist assessments and therapies for children and young people that stammer, appropriate research, and the training of speech and language therapists across the country.

In 2016/17 the Charity helped more than 4,000 children and young people who stammer through a range of initiatives and projects including both at the MPC, and with other partners across the UK, including:

- Our Helpline
- Supporting Specialist Assessment Services
- Training Speech and Language Therapists in stammering
- ASC Youth Panel, involving 15 young people from across the UK
- Research
- · Talking Out residential in North Yorkshire and Staffordshire
